<sup>20</sup> It was there at Gilgal that Joshua piled up the twelve stones taken from the Jordan River.

<sup>21</sup> Then Joshua said to the Israelites, "In the future your children will ask, 'What do these stones mean?' <sup>22</sup> Then you can tell them, 'This is where the Israelites crossed the Jordan on dry ground.'"

<sup>23</sup> For the Lord your God dried up the river right before your eyes, and he kept it dry until you were all across, just as he did at the Red Sea when he dried it up until we had all crossed over.

<sup>24</sup> He did this so all the nations of the earth might know that the Lord's hand is powerful, and so you might fear the Lord your God forever."

### LESSON #1:

**You can't get the Promised Life without making** \_\_\_\_\_.

➤ "Inside the Tent of Meeting, the Lord would speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend. Afterward Moses would return to the camp, but the young man who assisted him, Joshua son of Nun, would remain behind in the Tent of Meeting."

~Exodus 33:11

### LESSON #2:

**Establish celebration** \_\_\_\_\_.

<sup>2</sup> At that time the Lord said to Joshua, "Make flint knives and circumcise the Israelites again."

<sup>3</sup> So Joshua made flint knives and circumcised the Israelites at Gibeath Haaraloth.

<sup>4</sup> Now this is why he did so: All those who came out of Egypt—all the men of military age—died in the wilderness on the way after leaving Egypt.

<sup>5</sup> All the people that came out had been circumcised, but all the people born in the wilderness during the journey from Egypt had not.

Joshua 5:2-

### LESSON #3:

**The Promised Life requires** \_\_\_\_\_.

<sup>1</sup> Now the gates of Jericho were securely barred because of the Israelites. No one went out and no one came in.

<sup>2</sup> Then the Lord said to Joshua, "See, I have delivered Jericho into your hands, along with its king and its fighting men".

~Joshua 6:1-2

### LESSON #4:

**Pray less,** \_\_\_\_\_.

<sup>3</sup> March around the city once with all the armed men. Do this for six days.

<sup>4</sup> Have seven priests carry trumpets of rams' horns in front of the ark. On the seventh day, march around the city seven times, with the priests blowing the trumpets. <sup>5</sup> When you hear them sound a long blast on the trumpets, have the whole army give a loud shout; then the wall of the city will collapse and the army will go up, everyone straight in."

~Joshua 6:3-5
